MODERATE	OCRA Head Coach on cell	 Capsize or swamp in zones 1 and 2 Rowing, zone 1 Paddling. Collision among OCRA boats "Near-miss" events due to poor judgment, equipment issue, unexpected weather conditions, etc. Injuries requiring first aid attention but not a medical emergency 	AS NEEDED
MINOR	Coach decision	 Incident resulting in minor equipment damage (Repair sheet must be completed) Minor injuries outside of the expected injuries from rowing or paddling such as blisters, scrapes, calf bites, etc. 	AS NEEDED
